Claremorris Pastoral Team meeting: which took place during the week, focused on the liturgies for St Patrick's and Easter, which are planned by the Liturgy group. Also the issue of major works on the Church building on the roof, windows and stonework. More information will be known in a few weeks. The team also plans on the re-introduction of Mass Servers, and Baptism Team. It is also considering the introduction of a pay and display system for the Church Car Park, as excessive parking is causing serious problems, especially for funerals, weddings and other Church liturgies taking place during the weekdays.

Barnacarroll Pastoral Team: focused on the liturgies for St Patrick's and Easter. It was decided to continue with The Easter Morning Dawn Mass. A suggestion was made to the Team to consider the introduction of Exposition of The Blessed Sacrament. An agreement was reached to have Exposition after the 9.30am Mass on Tuesday mornings, until 12 Noon. This will probably begin after Easter as a rota will have to be set up and also there will be a need for the availability of Eucharistic Ministers, to close the Exposition. The Team also planned on the re-introduction of Mass Servers.

Our grateful thanks to members of the Care and Maintenance Team who are planning on installing the historic Holy Water Font from Kilcolman.
